

Greetings to Faith Cabin Library Friends:

We rejoice that you have made "book sharing" a project in your conference for the coming year. Your interest, prayers and concern for those served in this work greatly encourages us.

This leaflet, and attached reprint of an article from the January 1955 WORLD OUTLOOK is sent with a two-fold purpose: 1. To let you know how much we appreciate your interest and help; 2. To offer a few suggestions and instructions for sending the books you may collect for this work.

WE NEED GOOD USED BOOKS: Every book in the 80 libraries has been a gift. If a book has been useful and helpful to you, to members of your family, it will certainly find a place of usefulness in this work. We need books for small children, for children of school age, for teen-agers, for adults. We need good fiction, history, biography, literature, travel, science, reference books. Any good books will be welcomed and widely used.

If the need for books is presented to each society, I am sure your will have a response. IF someone from the WSCS will arrange to have the matter presented to the Church School in your Church, I am sure some of the classes will "share" books. This is an important source of books for children. It also enables you to carry the need for books to some families in the Church who may not be affiliated with the Woman's Society.

Books do not have to be boxed in wooden boxes. If you have as much as 100 pounds or more, I believe prepaid freight will be the cheapest way to send the books. The books should be packed in medium-sized cardboard boxes and roped securely. They will make the trip after this fashion. ALL BOOKS "shared" MUST BE SENT BY PREPAID TRANSPORTATION. We can sign a Supply Voucher for the freight charges, which will give you credit.

ALL BOOKS and letters should be sent to FAITH CABIN LIBRARY, Paine College, AUGUSTA, GEORGIA. The name of the person to who an acknowledgement should be sent should be the return address on the parcels.

We are primarily interested in good used books. If some societies prefer to send new books, these are welcome also. If some society would like to have a larger share in the work, love offerings can be directed to us. These should be sent through the regular channels, but SPECIFICALLY-DESIGNATED for FAITH CABIN LIBRARY, PAINE COLLEGE, AUGUSTA, GEORGIA. Such gifts help buy new books, help supply gas and oil for the Faith Cabin Library Station Wagon and help supply the needed postage to carry on.

Gift subscriptions to magazines also make an important addition to this work.
